Policy Statement Regard Penalties for Unreserved Capacity

Effective October 1, 2018, the following policy will apply to Sections 9.3 and 10.2 of Schedule 21-EM of the ISO New England Inc. Open Access Transmission Tariff (“Schedule 21-EM”), which is the open access transmission tariff for local service over the transmission system in the Emera Maine Bangor Hydro District:

Section 9.3 – Emera Maine Penalties for Exceeding Firm Capacity Reservation – Section 9.3 of Schedule 21-EM provides that, in the event that a transmission customer exceeds its firm reserved capacity at any Point of Receipt or Point of Delivery, Emera Maine may assess a penalty of up to 200% of the firm point to point transmission charge for the period during which the transmission customer exceeded its firm reserved capacity. In exercising the discretion afforded under this tariff section, in the event that a transmission customer exceeds its firm reserved capacity at any Point of Receipt or Point of Delivery, Emera Maine will assess a penalty at a rate of 100% of the firm point to point transmission charge as determined in accordance with Schedule J of Schedule 21-EM for the period during which the transmission customer exceeded its firm reserved capacity.
